It bolsters the capacity of public agencies' through innovative **pro bono project partnerships** with private-sector volunteers

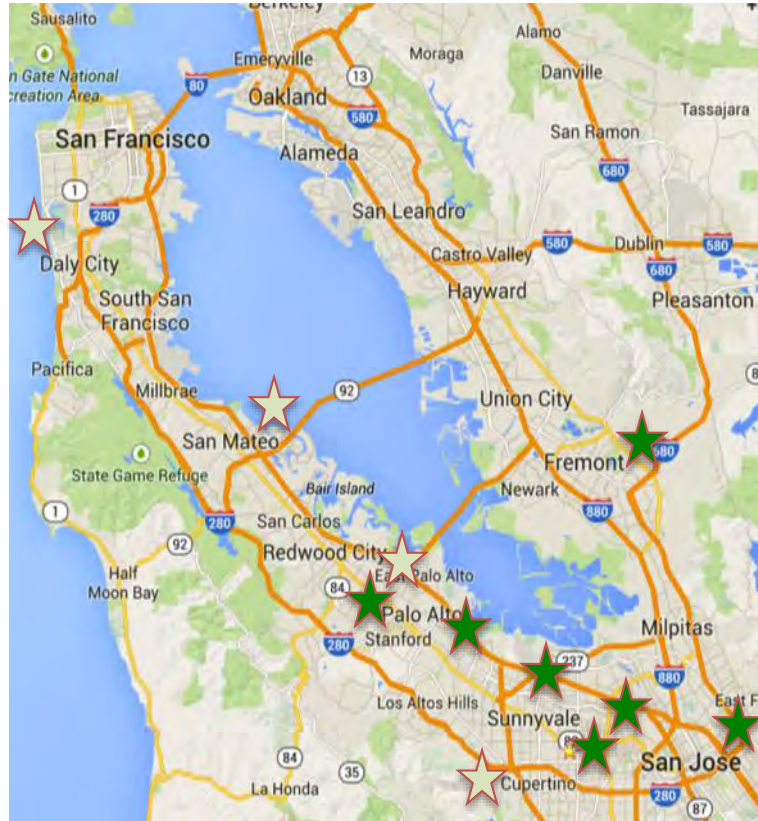


SVTP Metrics Dashboard

SVTP Engagement Status



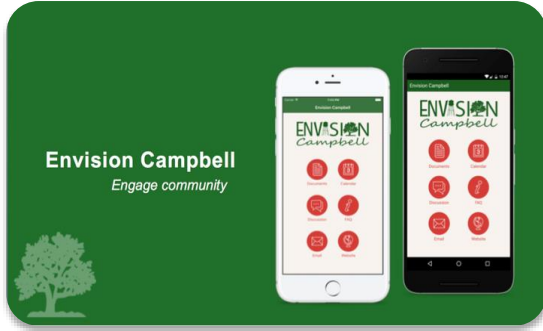

400+ students & family members from East San Jose attended Technovate, which brought together interactive tech & brightest minds from Silicon Valley to Alpha Public School.



Students attended **workshops** on *Virtual Reality, Design Thinking, Coding with Minecraft, LinkedIn tools* and *Square* led sessions on guide to a career in tech & scholarship for college

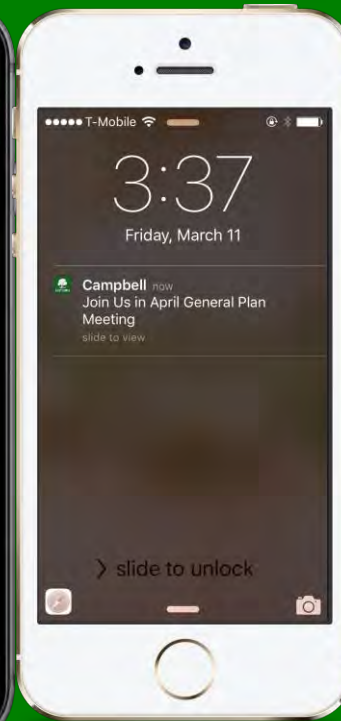
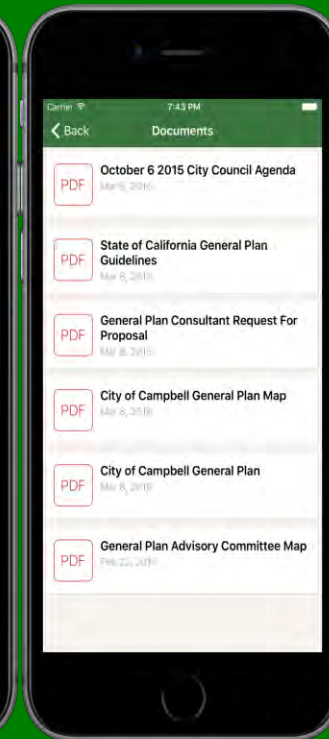
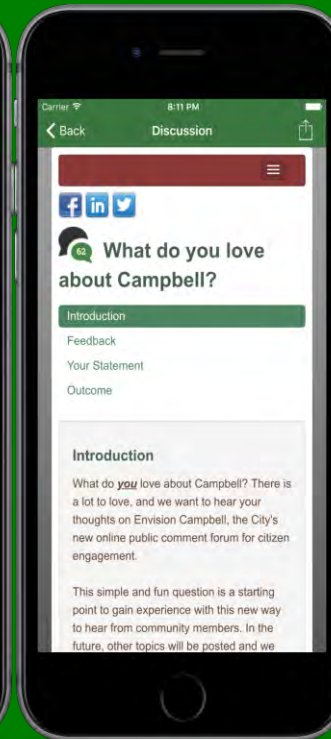
